

CORONAVIRUS UPDATE _ 13.03.2020_ Les Roches Crans Montana switches to on-line teaching

Due to the latest developments in the spread of the coronavirus, to align with Swiss federal and local authorities Les Roches Crans Montana Leadership Team will suspend temporarily all classroom teaching with effect from Monday, March 16th and for the following upcoming weeks. We will reassess measure upon situation developments.

In this complex context, we are committed to ensure the continuity of studies and are ready to deliver our curriculum through remote learning via our Moodle platform and additional digital solutions.

On Monday, March 16th 2020; In preparation for the implementation for transition to remote learning, all students will receive information from their Program Teams on how to connect to and download the applications. Our IT helpdesk will be available to support students.

As of Tuesday, March 17th, 2020 we will be switching all teaching to remote learning formats. Preparations for this transition, such as expanding the number of online lectures, have already been made and will now be implemented as a top priority.

During the suspension of face to face classes, campus will remain open providing food and beverage, accommodation and the student services including medical care. In addition to the academic experience, our first and foremost preoccupation is the wellbeing of our community during those moments.

The measures already taken for travel, events, hygiene precautions will continue to apply.

The protection of all Les Roches Crans Montana Community is the top priority for the Leadership Team. We will reassess these measures upon situation developments and keep communicating with you actively.

To this end it has continuously adapted and communicated all relevant protective and preventive measures since the mid- January.
